

How to Download the Adobe Digital Editions software to your Computer

- Start at our library's website: www.ctwpl.info
- Click on the blue Overdrive button in the middle below where it says "Download Audiobooks, eBooks and more!"



- You will be transferred to the Yavapai Library Network Digital Media Catalog. On the left-hand side you will see a blue column with many different links available. Scroll down to the bottom and under the heading "Digital Media Software" you will see a link titled "Adobe Digital Editions For eBooks." Click on this link.
- Click on the button that says "Get ADOBE Digital Editions"
- Click on the brown button that says "Install"
- You will see a box pop up that says "Setup will install Adobe Digital Editions in the following folder..." It is highly recommended that you do not change this. Click the install button and the software will begin downloading.
- Once completed you can click on the Close button. Next you have to agree to the terms, click on Agree and Adobe Digital Editions will automatically launch.
- The first time Adobe Digital Editions is launched you will be prompted to authorize your computer. Click on the link that says "Get an Adobe ID online"
- Click on the yellow "Create an Adobe Account" button
- You are only required to type information into the fields with asterisks next to them. After filling out the required information click on the continue button at the bottom. If all of the required information was typed in correctly you will have successfully created an Adobe ID. If you make a mistake it will ask you to go back and fill in the proper information in the proper field. Make sure you remember the email address and password you enter here.
- Once you have successfully set up your Adobe ID go back to Adobe Digital Editions and type in the email address and password you chose for your Adobe ID and click authorize.
- Your Adobe Digital Editions is now authorized and will automatically open when you download an eBook from the Yavapai Library Network Digital Media Catalog.
